CONFIRMATION REGISTRATION 2020/21

Baptism, the Eucharist, and the sacrament of Confirmation together constitute the "sacraments of Christian initiation," whose unity must be safeguarded. It must be explained to the faithful that the reception of the sacrament of Confirmation is necessary for the completion of baptismal grace. For "by the sacrament of Confirmation, [the baptized] are more perfectly bound to the Church and are enriched with a special strength of the Holy Spirit. Hence they are, as true witnesses of Christ, more strictly obliged to spread and defend the faith by word and deed."

Catechism of the Catholic Church #1285

The Sacrament of Confirmation requires a two year program of preparation for those in 9th, 10th, or 11th grade. As the junior and senior years of High School can be demanding in regards to academic and extracurricular commitments, it is encouraged that Candidates begin their preparation in 9th grade. This helps to foster community and faith alongside their peers. However, the two year journey can begin anytime until the senior year of High School.

Year 1 and Year 2 classes meet on alternating Sunday mornings with two opportunities to attend. Check the calendar attached for specific dates and times. Classes start in September 2020 until May 2021.

The candidate's family must be registered members of Holy Trinity Catholic Church and the online registration forms must be completed before beginning the classes. Please provide a copy of the candidate's Baptism and First Holy Communion certificate at the time of registration. All new candidates must attend one parent & candidate meeting with at least one of their parents before registration is complete.

MISSED CLASSES AND HIGH SCHOOL YOUTH MINISTRY

At Confirmation, our faith and membership in the Body of Christ is confirmed, or strengthened. In the rite of Baptism, we become new members of the body of Christ, but our journey does not end there. The decision to be baptized is followed by continued growth, learning, and witness as members of the body of Christ.

(Catechism 1316 and John Paul II, Redemptoris Missio 26).

Confirmation classes are important because they encourage **community and experience** in order to adequately prepare for reception of the Sacrament. Our
Pastor must be able to present Candidates to the Bishop at the Confirmation Mass
by saying, "The candidates presented are prepared and ready to receive the fullness of
Christian Initiation in the Sacrament of Confirmation".

"To be prepared and ready" refers to attending and participating in the classes along with regular Mass attendance. Attendance will be taken for each class and revisited throughout the journey to ensure we are able to present them to the Bishop fully prepared.

How to "make-up" missed Confirmation classes? As discussed at the parent/candidate meeting, the Confirmation classes are standalone. There is no "make-up" class that fully revisits the topic. However, if a class is missed through illness or because of an important family event, we ask that the candidate attends another Youth Ministry event and completes an at-home reflection assignment. Candidates are encouraged to attend a YM event to grow in faith with their parish community. They should also review the at-home reflection that will be sent via email. These opportunities for "make-ups" should only be used if necessary. Candidates are of course invited to Youth Ministry events in addition to class attendance. We meet every Wednesday in the Parish Hall for Bible Study from 7:00pm - 9:00pm and once a month for social nights. All high school students are invited!
