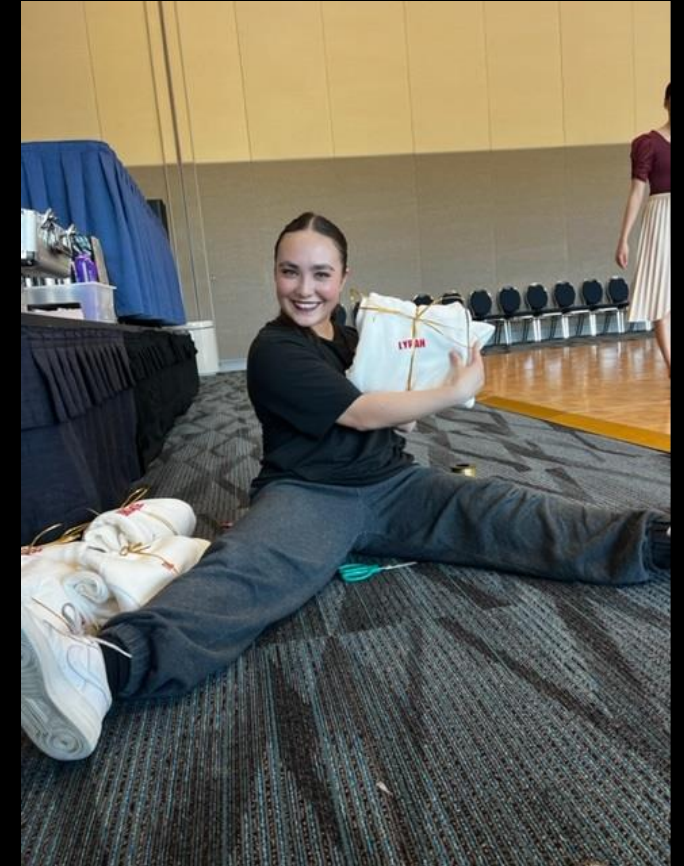
MY SERVICE
