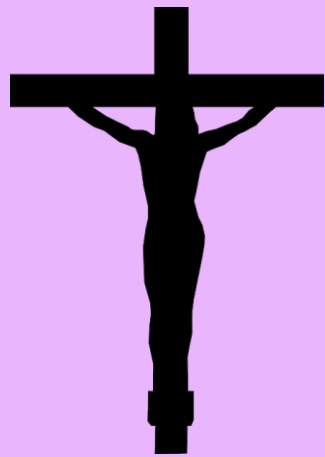


Discipleship Display
