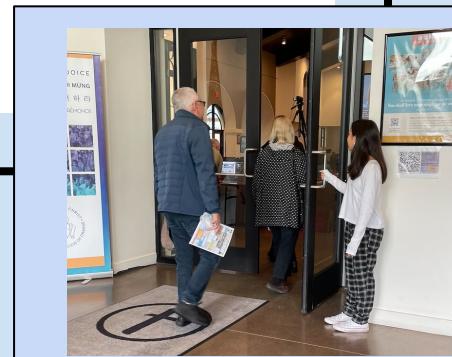

Discipleship Display

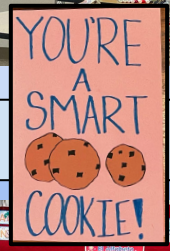
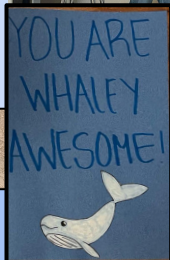
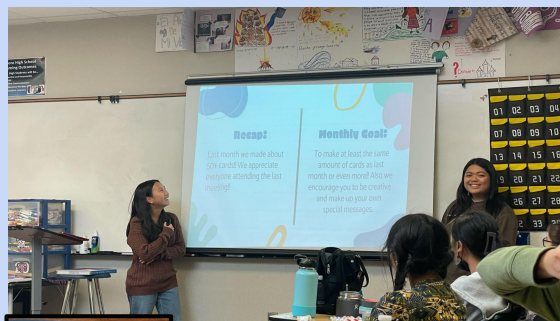
