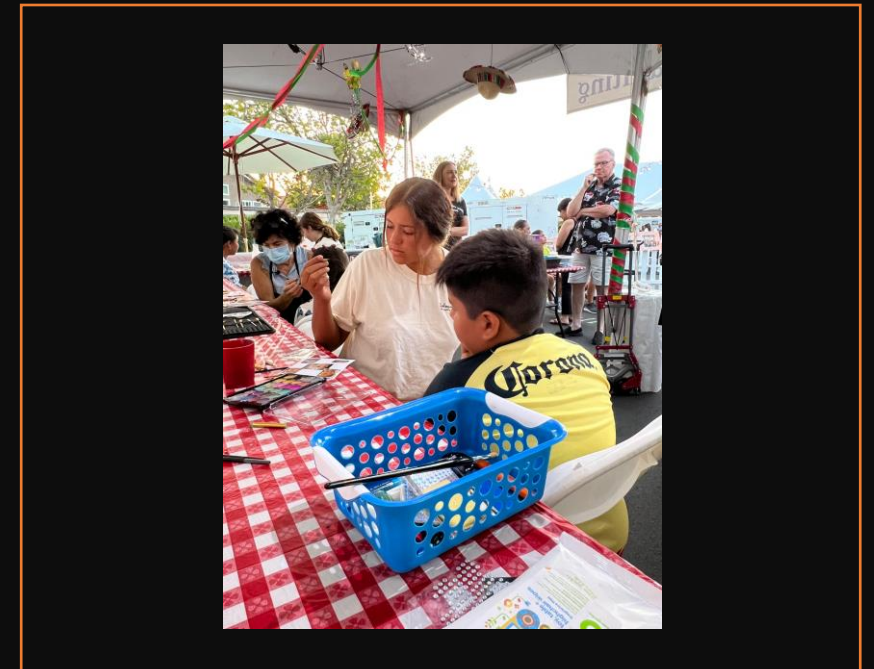
San Francisco Solano Food Bank
