Year 1 sessions will now meet on alternating Sunday evenings from 6:30-8:00 pm in the Parish Hall. ALL meeting dates are equally important in the preparation process. Attendance and participation are expected. Excessive absences may delay the preparation of the candidate. The Confirmation session time is purposefully designed to allow families and teens to attend mass together at our newly formed Youth Mass at 5:30 pm. "On Sundays and other holy days of obligation, the faithful are bound to participate in the Mass." - Catechism of the Catholic Church 2180.
