Faith Formation Years 3-5: 2024-2025 Schedule

Faith formation is an ongoing process. It is a family experience designed to bring light and life into your homes and hearts as you share the love of Jesus. This process will take place both at church and at home through regular family meetings and sessions guided by Pathways Wonder and Mercy.

There are a combination of 25 at home family meetings and 4 sessions at church. Students need to attend all church sessions with at least one parent. These sessions are designed to help parents guide and support you on this journey of faith with your children. All of the materials needed for the home family meetings will be distributed at the parent night. Please understand that all of these dates are important elements of the faith formation process. Make up opportunities will not be available.



Make a way with Wonder, an ongoing formation experience for the entire family. Families will encounter the power of storytelling in the parables of Jesus through engaging their imaginations, handson activities, and meaningful conversations. Through the 10 at home family meetings and 2 at church sessions, families will draw out the moral of each story and apply it to your daily lives.
