

DECREE

APOSTOLIC PAENITENTIARY, I in a very special way pay tribute to the Most Holy in Christ the Father and Our Lord, Lord of Divine Providence, Pope Leo the XIV, faithful Minister according to the laity of ours, His Excellency the Most Reverend Father, Lord God Bishop Vann, Bishop of Orange in California, kindly granted to you, in the name of the Most Holy Trinitarian Parishes of "Holy Trinity Ladera Ranch", by virtue of the Diocese, by choosing those who faithfully elect, after the divine sacrifice, impertinent to all who christify us, to be faithful with a charitable obligation, to be faithful with a plenary indulgence, to be blessed with the papal Benediction with an additional plenary indulgence, subject to the conditions (sacramental Confessions).
