

Faith Formation Years 3-5: 2025-2026 Schedule

Faith formation is an ongoing process. It is a family experience designed to bring light and life into your homes and hearts as you share the love of Jesus. This process will take place both at church and at home through regular family meetings and sessions guided by Pathways Sent.

There are 16 at home family meetings and 3 sessions at church. Students need to attend all church sessions with at least one parent. These sessions are designed to help parents guide and support you on this journey of faith with your children. All of the materials needed for the home family meetings will be distributed prior to the first meeting. Please understand that all of these dates are important elements of the faith formation process. Make up opportunities will not be available.

Make a way with Sent, an ongoing formation experience for the entire family. Families will be invited on a journey of discipleship and discernment. They will grow in the habits and practices of a disciple, equipping them to take up the mission of evangelization. Watch families take concrete steps to follow after Jesus as they are sent out everyday to classrooms, sports fields, work places, living rooms, and more - where they become witnesses for others, with Sent.
